As a part of our ongoing commitment to ensuring state government is open and accessible to Pennsylvania residents, we will be adding @pa.gov as the primary email domain for all commonwealth employees on Friday, July 29th. For example: [jsmith@state.pa.us](mailto:jsmith@state.pa.us) will now be [jsmith@pa.gov](mailto:jsmith@pa.gov).

While this project will activate @pa.gov as our visible email address, the old email addresses ending in @state.pa.us will continue to function so that emails will never be interrupted. Your emails will still be received if they are accidentally or unknowingly sent to the @state.pa.us address.

The current stationery items will be exhausted before new stationery items are printed so that nothing will be thrown out. In the meantime, if you receive any commonwealth stationery items printed with the @state.pa.us email addresses, please be aware of this cost-saving practice.

We appreciate your cooperation as we take a small step to increase the usability and consistency the commonwealth's online communications!
