Release of Version 1.0.0.0

The Department's LRFD Sign Structure Analysis program (SNLRFD) has been released.

The new program has been placed on PENNDOT servers for use by the Districts. Consultants and others can obtain the new program by submitting a Software order form along with a **fee of \$1,500**. The fee is waived for federal and state transportation agencies.

The Bureau of Bridge has released Change 8 to the April 2016 Edition of the Bridge Design Standards, BD-600M Series (Pub. 218M) and Change 8 to the September 2016 Edition of the Bridge Construction Standards, BC-700M Series (Pub. 219M), both dated July 10, 2025. Six (6) Bridge Design Standards and four (4) Bridge Construction Standards have been revised to update PennDOT's Sign Structures to meet AASHTO LRFD design requirements. Additionally, the Bridge Design and Bridge Construction Standards for 2 Post Planar Truss Sign Structures have been discontinued.

Publications 218M and 219M containing the revised standards are available on PennDOT's website from the [Forms and Publications](#) webpage or the [Plans, Standards and Specifications](#) webpage. The transmittal letters for Change 8 to each publication include a description of the changes, and the new revisions are indicated by light blue highlighting.
